I have a problem applying a custom group policy. This policy has an administrative template (removable\_storage.adm), downloaded from microsoft wich blocks removable storage. I loaded in AD and nothing happens to the computers in this OU.  
I also tried to use this in a group policy on a local computer, but still nothing.  
In the local group policy, if I make a change in Computer Configuration nothing happens. Only if I make a change in User Configuration changes are applied.  
The problem is the removable\_storage.adm is an Administrative Template for Computer Configuration.
