Hi,

I have seen several posts on this topic, but none of which relate to my specific situation:

- 1) Windows 2000 AD
- 2) One CA server – installed on a member server.
- 3) We want to install a new CA server on new hardware.
- 4) I need to know can I simply Install certificate services on the new hardware without doing any of the migration steps referenced in other posts. To my knowledge we do not need the old CA database for anything.
- 5) After installing certificate services on the new hardware and making sure it is working properly, I would then perform the decommissioning steps mentioned in the appropriate KB article.

My only concern in doing this is that I do not know the impact on the domain controllers....How do the DCs use the CA? Would I have to reconfigure anything on the domain controllers? Would this approach break anything?
