Even if the account in the domain and the local account on the computer are written the same, BUT there is no relationship between them. They have a different SID and will authenticate either on the domain via RDP which works, because of logging in to the domain server, not local on the computer or on the local computer and this account has no rights to the server shares. So add the computer to the domain and work with the domain user account.
