I'm by no means an expert in this subject matter of COM+ no MSDTC, but since no one has responded to your posting then I'll try to assist you to the best of my ability.

Because these errors usually indicate simple permissions related issues. Download and run Filemon (usually enough by itself) and Regmon from Sysinternals.com and then attempt the same steps again. For another customer we had, they were getting permission denied when trying to open the C:\ drive. We then found out that they had the identity of the COM+ application configured incorrectly. Identifying and correcting the permission issues should resolve these errors.

Keep us posted of you progress on the newsgroup, so that others can continue helping or learning from your experience.
