The error messages you would need to see are actually recorded in the cluster.log file in %systemroot%\cluster. Also, before going the drastic route of eviction, uninstall, reinstall, re-join...ensure all nodes in the cluster are listed as "Possible Owners" for all the resources in the group that is not failing over properly.
