I am stumped... When i try and create a new cluster the service does not start and then it deletes it self. I think it may be a security issue I have followed KB [articalhttp://support.microsoft.com/kb/269229](http://support.microsoft.com/kb/269229) to make sure that the cluster account has the proper permissions. I tried to use the domain admin account, when i use this account the cluster install's with no problem and the service is running.

Something interesting is if i add my cluster service account to the domain admin group it still does not work
