First an answer to your question :

for decimal 1240 / hex 0x4d8
ERROR_LOGIN_WKSTA_RESTRICTION winerror.h

So that will point to "security" or some sort of restriction, maybe group policy ?
what about the domain user account which is running the cluster service ?

Second, the real fault is in the following text "someone applied several MS patches"

Nobody should *just* install patches, you test them on your test cluster, prior to installing them on a production cluster.
And in a production cluster you only apply them on 1 node, then test it before applying to other node(s).

I would very strongly suggest that you change your processes of applying patches, and revoke admin rights (for this cluster) of the person who installed them in the first place, up to such time that this person is trained on the proper processes.
