I'll explain, if DHCP is in use at the office and at home it connects through a router or a computer that has ICS just configure it to obtain TCP/IP from DHCP. Then in TCP/IP properties go to the WINS tab and enable NetBIOS over TCP/IP, On XP the default NetBIOS setting is to use NetBIOS setting from the DHCP server, change that to Enable NetBIOS over TCP/IP.
