Can anybody help with it. I scanned for virus and found nothing.

I guess something is running in background after explorer.exe, But when i stop explorer its fine.

Steps taken:

msconfig.exe was not found on the machine. I copied it from another machine and ran it. Removed some startup files and restarted the machine. The problem didn't solve. Then again i tried to run the msconfig.exe and i got a message saying "C:\winnt\msconfig.exe" is not a valid windows file"
