> the logoff (saving settings etc.) is almost instantaneous. I've had a
> look around for any pointers, but so far haven't had much luck. I use
> a roaming profile, and have tried using the hive clean application –
> this worked on all but my 2003 servers – also it's not just me who
> has problems other people (who are setup the same as me), get the
> same errors.
