Possible. I didn't do nothing special when upfrading w2k3 server to SP-1. The problem just happened. So, yes. It seems be a issue with the way a domain works. A local server has the user rights applied locally. A domain controller has the user rights applied within a group policy.

Pass. Good news is that it's still working as it should.

> (so the tokens are cached by services.exe), but on reboot, the privileges
> are automatically added back to LocalService such that I cannot even get
> into your state.
