>
> I was having issues with Telneting to port 25 after SP1 was installed as
> well. It was also preventing a thrid party software from sending SMTP out.
>
> I discovered that McAfee Virus Protection 8.0 has a setting to prevent SMTP
> on port 25 for anything but MS products. This didn't seem to take affect
> until after I installed SP1.
>
> If you have McAfee Virus Protection 8.* installed on your machine you might
> check under "Access Protection" and "Port Blocking" you can switch the
> "Prevent mass mailing worms from sending mail" and this will free telnet
> access to port 25.
>
> (Obviously, unless your using a thrid party product to send SMTP out, you
> might not have a need to turn this off.)
>
