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I only glanced at the website – it appears this application is providing a GUI for group policy (a visual way to create the policies). It then writes the policy and adds it to the GP Objects and links to the specified OU. Based on the error message I would guess the problem is related to permissions. Check to be sure the user you are logged in as when running the application has the appropriate permissions to create and apply GPs to the groups in question. If you have to define an account within the application – check it. This feels like a username/password problem.

On a different note – if you have an MSI file you don't need this application. Using GP directly to do this is not difficult.

The software is <http://manageengine.adventnet.com/products/desktop-central/> it allows upto 10 machines for free to be controlled, deployment of MSI's, user control, and more. I've been posting on their forum too, but because of the time difference, and I'm guessing they reply during there working hours, I've turned to this group for support.

The Event log from the machine doesn't show anything, as the error reported stems back from the software, but as I've search around "Google" for the error, I'm presumed the error was a Windows error being returned into the software, hence turning here. There is not a lot more I can explain about it, as I'm new to all this Domain stuff, I'm having a play and learning as I go along. I've got to start somewhere..

I'm running some software that allows deployment of items, MSI's etc. Even time I use it, the software itself is working, but it can't seem to communicate with other machines 100%, I keep getting the error Could not create GPO(8007203a) The server is not operational, after a bit of research

I've come to the conclusion is it to do with the Group Policy? am I right, issues on the server?. Where would I add/change/modify some settings to allow all machines to communicate with each other with no restriction issues?

I've tried putting myself within the Administrators sections (General, and Domain), I've tried changing the settings for Remote Access (with the Allow checkbox ticked) and other things like that. I've tried adding my username onto the Server machine, and adding the server into my machine. But still nothing, am I missing something? or am I looking/trying in the completely wrong section?

Hope someone can help me with this matter.
