I have just set up a new Windows 2003 domain controller and after setting up the DC I ran a quick nmap scan of the box and have two open ports which concern me. They are ports 593 and 1026. I did a quick Google and port 593 (opened by svchost.exe) is related to http-rpc-epmap and port 1026 (opened by lsass.exe) is related to lsa-or-nterm. I do not have RPC over http proxy enabled and just to make sure I have doubled checked this by going to add/remove windows components/networking services and RPC over HTTP Proxy is not enabled. My question is how can I remove these or are they necessary services needed by the OS. I do not have an Exchange environment.
