Hi,

I have a Win2k SP4 member server with an odd problem. Any of the services will only start if using the "local system account". If I select any other account e.g. domain admin, I get a time out message when I try to start the service and a message saying the service could not be started. The local security policy "Log on as service" has the domain admins group as well as individual admin accounts listed. The Domain security policy "log on as service" is not defined. The domain controller is windows 2003.
