Hello Alex,

Unfortunatly you can no longer backup files and folders with server 2008. It uses VSS to backup complete volumes/harddisks. The only separat is the system state. The commandline tool wbadmin is also available. You can check it out, but without 3rd party software, you can't. But i think you can stop all services related to WSUS and copy the database to another server.
