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Does anyone know why windows 2003 would log off a user right after logon? I thought it may be due to a corrupt profile, so I logged into it for the first time and it happened to me. It only happens via console or RDP. Safe mode is fine. I dont see anything in the event viewer other than some apps that are being shutdown in mid stream due to the logoff. I am having the user check any programs or updates that were installed to compare this to when the server started showing issues. I also checked a chkdisk.
