I have several machines (about 27) I manage in a neat workstation config I put together all by myself! I am so proud... still undergoing testing, and it is almost perfect. It runs across three floors, work rooms, and private rooms in a youth hostel I manage. I am working on building a completely Vista based system eventually... but now it is a hybrid Windows XP & Vista system.... (Vista Ultimate all the way baby! Vista is very awesome and I love it!
