You can easily do it yourself: Instead of scheduling ntbakup.exe directly, schedule a batch file instead. It consists of two commands:

- a) The full ntbakup.exe command with all its switches.
- b) A command line mailer command that sends backup?.log to you.

blat.exe is such a command line mailer. You can download it from a number of sites.
