- 2.) IN VPC I just used "Connections to other access servers" policy and selected grant, do i have to create a whole new policy?

I think I remember when I was in the VPC and I was having the original problem with not having the option of selecting the "Control Access through Remote Access Policy", that I might of fixed it by upgrading the domain mode to windows 2003.
