Our current domain is X_Y_Z and our new domain name will be XYZ. Currently all these settings are under:

c:\documents and settings\jsmith

When I did a test bed to 2003 and logged into the "new" domain the folder that was created on SOME occasions was:

c:\documents and settings\jsmith.XYZ

Great now I have to reset passwords, log onto every system as the individual, recreate printers, icons, setup Outlook and import everything from their old local profile. Any way around this? Thanks.
