But if I do not need to use NT 4.0 BDCs, but do need to continue to provide users access to NT 4.0 file/application servers (member servers), could I accomplish this with the upgrade method? In other words, if I upgrade my PDC to Svr 03 AD, will NT 4.0 member servers still work right on the network?

- > These two requirements rule out migrating.
- > To use ADMT the AD domain must be in Win2k or later native mode. In native
- > mode your AD DCs will not replicate with NT BDCs.
- >
- > Migrating also requires a trust be set up between the two domains which you
- > can't do if they have the same name.
- >

- > Will your existing PDC support AD? If so upgrade it to Win 2k3, add the
- > "new" servers to the new as member servers then run dcpromo to make them
- > DCs.

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> If not consider promoting one of the other BDCs that can support AD to PDC,
> then upgrade to Win 2k3.

> If none of your servers will support AD, remove Win 2k3 from one of the
> "new" servers and install NT 4.0 on it as a BDC while connected to your
> existing network, promote to PDC, then upgrade to Win 2k3.
