| 2000 workstation and then utilizes their Netware client to map the
| appropriate drives on their workstation.

| having
| some difficulty configuring the user profiles (I guess). I need to be
| able to
| have the users keep all their current desktop settings (wallpaper, icons,
| screen savers, etc.) just as they were when they were accessing the
| Netware
| servers (it all needs to look and "feel" the same). Also can't seem to
| figure
| out how to map drives on login to the domain so everything appears as it
| was
| when they were using Netware. Is there any form of command reference for
| login scripts?
