To use a dos script you could try:

```
net use m: \\%computername%\%Sharename% /persistent:Yes
```

vbs would be better though. Open notepad and type the following:

```
Dim WSHNetwork
```

```
Set WSHNetwork = WScript.CreateObject("WScript.Network")
```

```
WSHNetwork.MapNetworkDrive "M:" , "\\%Computername%\%Sharename%"
```

```
WshNetwork.AddWindowsPrinterConnection
```

```
"\\%Computername%\%SharedPrinterName%" (if required)
```

Save this files as filename.vbs
