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Tony thanks for the help. I ran the diagnostics, it seems that the Sysvol replicates sometimes ok and other times with errors. How can you fix this? I have a 2000 Server and 2003 Server, I have moved the operations masters and some other services to the newer server because the 2000 is only 366 mhz with about 350mb of ram. I am new here and the 2000 has been neglected for a long time. For instance when you run disk defrag the entire disk is almost red, however when you run defragmenter it says it completes but still displays all red(fragmented files).

One other thing: Wwhen running netdiag and dcdiag the first lines usaully indicate the server name address and os. My 2003 server is saying os 2000(build 7903 or some number?) is that normal?
