Thanks for posting here. Also thanks for Todd and Michael's kindly replies.

Based on my experience, you may test the following steps for this issue:

1. Stop and re-start Computer Browser service with services.msc or use:
net stop browser
net start browser
2. Disable Windows Firewall/Internet Connection Sharing (ICS) service with services.msc.
3. Restart the server.
4. If the issue persists after above steps, please refer to the following KB article for further troubleshooting:
