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I have had A LOT of trouble with HP printers lately, *especially* the 2300 series. Most of our problems were driver-related. A good way to test whether the printer and JetDirect (printer NIC) are communicating is to tell the printer to print a configuration page (on the Information menu). It should print two pages – one for the base printer unit and one for the JetDirect card. If you only get one page, then your NIC is either not seated properly, or it is bad. Even if it is not connected to the network, you should still get its configuration page printed out.
