> certificate to log you on". I have set up a CA and RADIUS server and
> they seem to be working fine. I have set a computer certificate to
> be deployed using auto-enrollment and I have verified that computers
> are receiving the computer certificate. I have set the 802.1x
> authentication options on the client computers to authenticate using
> computer information when available. When I request a user
> certificate and try to authenticate it works fine, but when I delete
> the user cert and still have the computer cert, it fails. It seems
> like Windows is not even looking at the computer certificates when it
> decides what cert to send in for authentication. Any ideas? I have
> been pulling my hair out and I cant figure this one out. Any help
> would be greatly appreciated.
