It is a hold over from the days of NT using NetBIOS names and LAN broadcasts. So i'm guessing that network places builds its list from netbios broadcasts. everything is good to go now. however, i'm trying to enable netbios over tcp/ip in the dhcp server options, but i cant seem to get it. would you happen to know how to do that? i would like it so that all my clients are automaticaly configured with netbios over tcpip from dhcp
