I wonder why I can't do enabling routing and remote access service in a server running Windows 2003 Std SP1 because everytime I try to, a dialog box pops up saying that ICS (Internet Connection Sharing) is enable on this computer. I have done to stop and disable Windows Firewall/ICS service through the service console.

What seems to be the problem? Is it related to Incoming Connections that exists that I can't remove (reappear although I deleted it)?

Any kind of assistances is appreciated very much.

Yes. Incoming connections interface is the reason. You should delete it permanently (and stop Remote Access Connection Manager and Remote Access Auto Connection Manager services).

Thanks Nick, but I can't delete that Incoming Connection because whenever I do it, RRAS service become disabled and if I re-enable the RRAS again then the Incoming Connection come up again.

Really no idea why is it so?
