

microsoft.public.windows.server.sbs: Re: dns error when opening companyweb on client

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If that doesn't work, Can you hit <https://companyweb> ? How about <http://localhost>? <https://localhost>?

If the DNS settings are out of whack on your clients, you can check the DHCP service options and make sure the DNS servers option is set with the server address.

Remember to go to a command prompt and do an "ipconfig /flushdns" and "ipconfig /registerdns" to make sure the new info gets through to the client.
