>Quick background: DSL modem is an NB1300 modem/router
>running in bridged mode (not routing) which is connected
>to a dlink DI624 wireless broadband which is acting as
>the router. This is connected to my the external network
>adapter on the sbs2003 and the remainder of the network
>is connected to the internal adapter of the same
machine.

>

>I have opened all the appropriate ports on the 624's
>firewall and allowed WAN access ie -
>25,80,443,444,4125,1723,3389 and I still have no joy
when
>trying to access the server externally.

>Both of the networking devices have the latest firmware
>installed and I'm really open to any suggestions that
>anyone may have.
