To capture a screenshot:

- a. Press the 'Print Screen' key on your keyboard (it may instead appear as 'PrnScrn', or something similar)
- b. Click Start->Programs->Accessories and select the Paint program.
- c. In the Paint program, select the Edit menu, and then select Paste.
- d. Save this file and email it to me as an attachment.
