

Re: SBS03 VPN Client Loses Internet Connection when VPN Established

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> *I have an issue with three separate SBS2003 installations (premium, with ISA Server) so I figure this is either by design or i'm doing something wrong..*

Since these are all with ISA server...the VPN clients need to either install the ISA Firewall client and point it to the SBS server they're VPN'd into, or go into IE and change the proxy settings to point to the SBS server they're VPN'd into (port 8080 is the default).

If that doesn't work, what is the specific error that comes back when they try to do things on the Internet?

> I ran the VPN setup tool on the admin menu, and in fact a VPN client will connect fine. Once they are connected over the internet it lets them map a drive through dos. However, the second they connect until the second they disconnect they lose all internet access. interestingly enough an open Terminal services window continues fine, but they lose internet, they lose AOL instant messenger, etc.

> I have one employee who realized if he plugs his broadband right into his PC without using a router, that he doesn't lose internet. I also tried this on a machine that had no internet to start with (disabled lan connection and made a dial up connection to the vpn sbs03 machine). With the dialup,
