> problem because I can now send and receive mail from mail
> clients on and off the LAN.

> The problem seems to lie with accessing the WAN NIC.
> Here's why:

> you're trying to access from the server, does that
> connect? <<

> I can telnet in from a workstation via the LAN NIC
> (telnet 192.168.1.204 25), but not via the WAN NIC
> (192.168.2.204). Likewise, I can't telnet in via the
> public IP because the router/firewall forwards the
> request to the WAN NIC which seems to be where the
> problem manifests itself.

> I think we're zeroing in on the problem, but I'm just not
> sure what needs to be done next.
