As mentioned in my original post, sqlagent\$sbsmonitoring is set for auto start as a local system account. However, it doesn't start at boot and won't start thereafter. It terminates immediately after attempting to start it going.

That's the problem I'm trying to resolve.

>For the 103 error regarding sqlagent\$sbsmonitoring can you check in

>Start/Administrative Tools/Services and see if the service is running and

>should be configured to run as Local System. You should be able to right

>click on the service and select Properties and then click on the Log On tab

>to set it to logon as Local System account (interact with desktop should not

>be checked).

>

>With the SBSMonitoring instance it does need to be running in order to run

>it's scheduled jobs to do things such as remove entries that are older than

>90 days (by default) from the database.
