>> *I deleted the icwlog.txt file and reran the wizard then I found the
>> following two lines:*
>> *error 0x8007203a returned from call to Enabling wireless admin for oma ()*
>> *error 0x8007203a returned from call to CEMailCommit::Commit()*

>> *researching the error number on MS yeilded nothing relating to the problem I
>> am having. Presently I am about two seconds from formatting and starting
>> over. Hopefully someone can give some insight on this problem. Following is

>> *I am working with a brand new SBS 2003 Server in a test environment. All was
>> going well with the exception of receiving email. After researching and*

> > *discovering the Service Patch 1, I installed it and now I am receiving an*
> > *error when running the "Configure Email & Internet Connection Wizard": An*
> > *error occurred while configuring a componet. To continue and configure*
> > *remaining components, click ok. To cancel the wizared, click cancel. The*
> > *error occurs during the Email Configuration portion of the wizard and there*
> > *are no entries in the event logs. I have found this same problem on this site*
> > *in two other posts, but it was never addressed.*
> >
> > *The server is running a single nic with a router on a DSL connection. My ISP*
> > *has the correct records in DNS for both my domain name and MX. The server is*
> > *staticly addressed and all incoming network traffic is diverted to it. (DMZ).*
> > *I have tried unchecking all of the email related options in the wizard, but*
> > *still get the same error. I am still able to access the Remote Outlook Access*
> > *via a remote workstation, but havent tried accessing with a local as I know*
> > *there is something wrong because of the error. My server is set to use it's*
> > *self as primary DNS server and outside DNS requests are being forwarded to my*
> > *ISPs DNS servers. That all seems to function fine. Any help would be greatly*
> > *appreciated as I am at a loss on this one.*

> > *Any clues on why I am not receiving incoming email would be great also.*
> > *Sends fine, but does not receive regardless of using local connection or*
> > *remote and exchange shows no mail waiting to be picked up at all. I think*
> > *that problem has to do with dns.*
