Prospects are good, Toby :-). It just takes a bit of grunt work.

If you end up going 'bog standard' (which is probably a very good idea on a first install), then you will probably reach a point on your second or third install where you'll have some real good ideas of how you want to set the box up. That third install would probably be intended as the production install.

Anyway, even if you go bog standard on your production install, here's everything you need to move the growth (data) items onto a separate disk/partition.
