- > lost and this is my production server and tomorrow morning, all the clients
- > I havent joined to the new network yet will come in and I'll be a dead duck.
- > Any help at all would be gratefully received. P.s. the event logs don't show
- > any trouble either. But the DNS is empty of external domains in the cache.
- > It doesn't figure.
