Thank you for posting in SBS newsgroup.

If you are a local administrative user, you should have the permission to install and launch the applications. By default, the application should be launched with the current user's credential. If you want to check this, you can open the Task Manager and then check if the application is running under your current logon account.

For the issue regarding why the application doesn't create those registry keys, it is better if you could contact the developer or the support of that application. This is because that we do not have any resource regarding this third party application and we do not know why this happened.
