- > SQL Server (standard Edition) on their (Small Business Server), so I have
- > sold them SBS 2003. Now the owner of the business takes the database home on
- > his notebook PC, and needs to do development work and testing while away from
- > the office. He needs a copy of Personal Edition to do this, as the notebook
- > runs Windows XP Pro. If he had purchased SQL Server Standard Edition as a
- > seperate product, it would have also included Personal Edition. Instead he
- > purchased it bundles with Small Business Server (because I told hime that SBS
- > 2003 Premium included Personal Ed of SQL Server), and I now need to know if
- > inead he can install and run Personal Edition as well as Standard Edition.
- > If this is not the case, then there is obviously a difference between the
- > standard edition that is sold as a seperate product and the standard edition
- > that is bundled with SBS, which makes life extremely difficult for me as a
- > reseller. I have searched the MS site for info on this, and other than the
- > doc I quoted from in my previous reply, I haven't been able to find an
- > answer. All I could find was that SBS 2003 Premium includes SQL Server
- > Standard Edition, which one would assume also includes Personal Edition
- > (because Personal comes with Standard).
