Thanks for your reply.

By default, all domain users must have the Logon Locally permission in this domain policy. I do not know what happened but it seemed that this policy was modified by some one. SBS will not automatically modify this setting.

In addition, please open the Local Group Policy editor on the problematic client by running the command "gpedit.msc" to see if only the Admins were allowed to logon locally. By default, it should allow all users to logon.
