| I am using a Microsoft Small Business Server 2003 Premium (with ISA and MS SQL).

| Now I installad the actual version of Microsoft Baseline Security Analyzer, and performed a check of my system.

| There are two errors I can't resolve:

| 1. I have to users, which are service accounts with domain-user priviliges. MBSA told me to change the Internet Explorer settings for these users to default, but I don't know how. For the Administrator it's no problem, but I can't log in with the service accounts, so how should I set the IE settings for those accounts?

| 2. On the server runs the SBSMONITORING on MSDE and SHAREPOINT and MS-SQL on MS-SQL. Now I get the error, that these services use the Local System account, which is not save. There was no problem to change the service account for SHAREPOINT and MS-SQL. I did this in the SQL-Systemmanger, but I don't know how to change the service account for SBSMONITORING. If
