I tried both of these but there is no change.

As an experiment I've just stopped the SMTP and Routing services and sent a message through to a bogus address. It gets into the vsi 1\Pickup folder and has the following header:

This strikes me that the SMTP connector will not be able to deliver it, as the header information has not been changed, it will be looking for Postmaster@domain, and it isn't there.

Any ideas?

- > 5. Start "Microsoft Connector for POP3 Mailboxes" service.
- > 6. Run IISreset command from start menu.
