When I try to click <external IP> I get a login page (https).

If I try http://<external IP> I get the "Welcome to Windows Small Business Server 2003" page.

As I mentioned before RWW works internally. I didn't change anything at the server (one NIC config).

I can access RWW only by using the external IP, and I see no reason why it shouldn't work as it did before.

The router was configured with all the ports needed: 80, 443, 444, 3189 and 4125.

After this started I ran the CEICW wizard at least twice but nothing helped.
