Hi Charles,

I have ran dcpromo again, rebooted the server so changes made could take affect and checked the print queues afterwards. So far everything seems to ok, except for a few warning logs I'm receiving in Directory Service (event id: 1153, source: ntds general, category: ds schema) about inheritance was ignored and in the FRS (event id: 13508, source: ntfrs, category: none).

Description:

The File Replication Service is having trouble enabling replication from servername to servername for c:\windows\sysvol\domain using the DNS name servername.ssastructural.local. FRS will keep retrying.

Following are some of the reasons you would see this warning.

[1] FRS can not correctly resolve the DNS name

servername.ssastructural.local from this computer.

[2] FRS is not running on ssasbs2k3.ssastructural.local.

[3] The topology information in the Active Directory for this replica has not yet replicated to all the Domain Controllers.
