>for us and our customers. Setting up a test network did throw up another
>problem.

>We have a webserver running and that means that all traffic arriving at
>the firewall at port 443 is forwarded to the webserver. So now we have
>the following problem that the /exchange url (to access OWA) gets
>redirected to port 443 and thus sending us to the webserver instead of
>the OWA logon. We tried to make a new rule (sending /exchange:90 to the
>correct IP) in the firewall using a different port but after accepting
>the certificate you still get forwarded to 443 (and our webserver).

Can you create a proxy which acts on the virtual host? This will then work as follows:

Remote client connecting to public ip --> router --> port mapping to internal webserver --> requested host matches rule --> proxy requests to SBS internal server.
