- > For your error information-WINS 4204 event, the issue may be the result of
- > a destination host unreachable message being sent in response the WINS
- > service Automatic Partner Configuration function. This can be a printer or
- > other network device that is not responding. The default is for a
- > multicast service announcement to be sent out over the wire every 40
- > minutes. The feature is designed to let the WINS servers announce
- > themselves for automatic replication. The idea is as an alternative to
- > statically configured WINS replication partnerships. Most people are not
- > using this and your issue should be easily resolvable with the following
- > registry settings:
