My clients (from their desktops) can execute programs that are linked to \\Network-server\DBfolder. But me (remotely accessed to the server) cannot. So, looks like I have put more restrictions on the Administrator, than I have on my clients/users. (Never thought that this was possible)

Since, my clients are in production, I will wait until after-hours to play with the permissions.

- > This sounds like a permissions issue, when you are accessing from the C:
- > directly the NTFS SECURITY permissions being used only – When you Access
- > using the \\ you are accessing through a server share and the Share
- > permission is applying
- >
- > Please check the share permissions for this folder, remember by default 2003
- > sets READ ONLY on shared folders.
- >
- > If still no joy, please post both your SHARE and SECURITY (NTFS) permissions
- > on here.
