My problem is after the SBS SP1 update as done per the detailed instructions.

Two issues have now arisen. First in the Backup always fail owing to VSS, I have tried various steps I have seen in this forum but does not work.

Error is

I have used vssadmin and can list volumes and 1 provider but when I list writers it takes about 15mins to display info and all appears fine?.

My second problem is due to the sharepoint service and unable to display company web site.

Error I get is this
